Make something which could be sold in a bakery and take a photo to show us, or maybe you could bring it in for us to try.</p>	<p>Samuel Pepys wrote a diary of the events during the Great Fire of London. Keep your own diary for a weekend. Try to include everything you do!</p>	<p>Visit a local bakery. What do they sell? How do you think the bakery on Pudding Lane was different from our bakeries today?</p>
<p>Create a model of a building or a scene from London in 1666. Please do not make large models as we have limited room to display them!</p>	<p>FRIDAY 4th NOVEMBER IS OUR 'HISTORY OFF THE PAGE' DAY. PLEASE SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL DRESSED IN CLOTHES FROM THE PERIOD OF THE GREAT FIRE OF LONDON.</p>	<p>Research more about the Great Fire of London or about Samuel Pepys and make a short presentation to share with the class.</p>
<p>Create a map showing how the fire spread across London.</p>	<p>Talk about how you prevent a fire in your home. Do you have smoke alarms?
