

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>The School</b></p> <p><b>We will</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Nurture your child’s personal, spiritual, moral, educational and social development.</li> <li>• Provide your child with a set of values by which to live, through a programme of Values Education.</li> <li>• Encourage and promote politeness and good manners.</li> <li>• Provide an education within and upholding a caring Christian environment, whilst ensuring respect for other faiths.</li> <li>• Provide your child with a broad and balanced curriculum to meet their individual educational needs and enable them to make progress.</li> <li>• Encourage your child to work hard and to do their best.</li> <li>• Inform you of your child’s progress through regular consultations and an annual written report.</li> <li>• Provide and monitor activities for completion at home in accordance with the school’s Homework Policy.</li> <li>• Work with you in a mutually open, respectful and tolerant manner to ensure your child’s well-being.</li> <li>• Ensure that everyone concerned with your child feels welcome and valued in the school.</li> <li>• Keep you informed about the school and its activities through regular updates and the school’s website.</li> <li>• Provide a safe, orderly, well-resourced environment and clear expectations that each will take care of one another and of everything around them.</li> <li>• Follow and make available to you on request, the school’s policies and guidelines in all aspects of school life.</li> <li>• Adhere to statutory Child Protection requirements. This may mean referrals to outside agencies.</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>The Parents/Carers</b></p> <p><b>I/We will</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure my/our child comes to school regularly and on time.</li> <li>• Ensure that my/our child is well-rested, refreshed, alert and ready to learn.</li> <li>• Notify the school of any reason for absence, by telephone initially and then confirming in writing.</li> <li>• Avoid holidays in term time except under wholly exceptional circumstances, recognising them as detrimental to my/our child’s education.</li> <li>• Ensure my/our child wears correct, ‘named’, school uniform.</li> <li>• Encourage my/our child to be honest, polite and well-mannered.</li> <li>• Make the school aware of any problems or concerns that may affect my/our child’s learning &amp; behaviour.</li> <li>• Support my/our child in home learning activities, read regularly with him/her and encourage him/her to try their best in all school activities.</li> <li>• Work with the school and its agencies in a mutually open, respectful and tolerant manner to ensure my/our child’s well-being.</li> <li>• Attend parent consultations, information meetings and support school functions.</li> <li>• Follow the school’s Health &amp; Safety advice on accessing and using the school grounds and accept responsibility for my child outside school hours.</li> <li>• Support the school’s policies and guidelines in all aspects of school life.</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>The Pupil</b></p> <p><b>I will try to</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Attend school each day, on time.</li> <li>• Ensure that I have the right equipment and that I am awake and ready to learn.</li> <li>• Work hard and always do my best.</li> <li>• Ask for help if I need it.</li> <li>• Do my homework to the best of my ability and hand it in on time.</li> <li>• Be involved and active in school life.</li> <li>• Be honest.</li> <li>• Be polite, considerate and well-mannered.</li> <li>• Have respect and tolerance for the feelings and opinions of others; getting on with them and treating them as I want to be treated.</li> <li>• Respect and care for others and their property both in school and outside.</li> <li>• Think of my own and others’ safety and behave in a way that ensures a safe and secure environment.</li> <li>• Own my own behaviour – YOYOB!</li> </ul>
