Year 5 and 6 thoroughly enjoyed their residential trip to Aylmerton last week. The children experienced rock pooling and had a great time hunting for fossils.

They were also lucky to experience exciting activities such as rope climbing and a walk along Cromer beach. A great time was had by all.



### **Science Day**

Meanwhile, back at St Andrew's we've continued with some exciting learning as it was our Science Day on Tuesday. During the morning, we were very fortunate to have had a visit from the Planetarium belonging to the University of Hertfordshire. The children from Reception to Year 6 were able to take a tour through space, immersed in 360 degree imagery. It was very exciting and certainly one of those awe and wonder moments we like so much in science.



The **Reception** class have been celebrating Science Day with a visit to the planetarium, using rocks and sand to investigate how the moon's craters are made, and working together to build a giant marble run across the EYFS garden!



















**Year 3** had lots of fun in for Science Day. They conducted an experiment to see if the people with the largest hands were able to pick up the most pasta. They also visited the planetarium and had a tour of our solar system. They found out that mostly the people with the largest hands were able to pick up the most pasta and mostly the people with the smallest hands were able to pick up the least pasta. They drew a bar graph to show the results.





This week in **Nursery**, they also celebrated Science Day. Mrs Lovell created an experiment to complete using Gummy Bears. The children had a look at different Gummy Bears, speaking about their shape, size and colour. Children then had to predict what would happen to a Gummy Bear after spending 24 hours in water. The next day, they had a look at the bears and compared the ones that were put in water to the ones they had left out of the water. They discovered that the bears had lost their colour and they had more than doubled in size.





### **Science Day Assembly**

Each class presented their learning from Science Day in a special assembly. It was so great to see all the imaginative ways the children came up with presenting their findings.
