# **Attendance Policy**

As you may have heard on the news, the Department for Education has produced statutory guidance for maintained schools, academies, independent schools, and local authorities. It is called "Working together to improve school attendance" and it includes a National Framework in relation to absence and the use of legal Every Day Counts.... sanctions. Accordingly, Hertfordshire County Council have updated

their model policy, which, as a County Maintained School, we will be reviewing at our next Full Governor Meeting in October.

The draft policy can be found on our website for you to read. Please be aware that under this national framework there is now a single consistent national threshold for when a penalty notice must be considered by all schools in England, of 10 sessions (usually equivalent to 5 school days) of unauthorised absence within a rolling 10 school week period. The 10 sessions of absence do not have to be consecutive and can be made up of a combination of any type of unauthorised absence. The 10-school week period can span different terms, school years or education settings.
