Year 4 Development Day at Wodson Park

Year 4 had a healthy start to their new year by taking part in the Wodson Park Development Day facilitated by the students at Presdales school, supported by the Hertford and Ware School Sports Partnership. The afternoon involved a range of activities including javelin, cricket, running and Bollywood dance! The children represented St Andrew's brilliantly and enjoyed the opportunity to try out all the different activities.



Key Stage 1 Police Morning

On Thursday, Year 1 and 2 were visited by Hertfordshire Police to learn about how the police service protects citizens and solves crimes. They looked for evidence in a crime scene, which the PCSOs set up on the playground. The children were taught how DNA helps to catch criminals, and how the police protect evidence from contamination with evidence bags. Each class also learned about police cars and got the chance to sit in one. They looked over the equipment that the police carry with them daily, and in their car, including a shield, traffic



accident signs and first aid equipment. The children really enjoyed their experience and were tasked with writing a report based on the evidence they collected.


