Science Work


This week Year 3 have been studying forces and friction. They have measured, in Newtons, how much force it took to move their shoes. The children gradually added more mass to the shoes (water in a

bottle) and recorded their results. They were surprised how much force they needed.

Later, as part of their English work, Year 3 went 'flying' to different countries, using their very own handmade 'passports'.



Meanwhile as part of their Science unit on 'Light', Year 6 have been creating periscopes. They had great fun using a net to create the structure and then using the finished product to spy on their friends and their teacher.




Year 5 are currently studying 'Living Things' in their Science lessons. This week we set up worm farms. The class collected the worms themselves and enjoyed setting up the farms.



SEND and Inclusion Corner

Families Feeling Safe have sent us the following information: We are running four 'Supporting Families with Protective Behaviours' courses starting soon for parents and carers including one for dads only. Places are fully funded by HCC Targeted Parenting fund for parents across Hertfordshire who may need some additional support. One of the courses will run in Broxbourne and the others will be online and are listed below.

This 8-week term time course can help parents and carers to:

- Understand what may be influencing their child's behaviour
- Understand how Feelings, Thoughts and Behaviour link together
- Respond to a range of feelings e.g. anger, frustration, anxiety, stress and worry
- Improve communication to build better relationships
- Build on their own and their child's strengths
- Learn strategies to help them and their family feel safe
