Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to school for our final half term of the academic year, which is always a very busy one; with the gathering of assessment data and ensuring all statutory tests are completed in a timely fashion. We also have the Year 6 leavers' production to look forward to, as well as many class trips.

The term started with a visit from our School Effectiveness Adviser who looked at writing throughout the school. He observed lessons, spoke to children and looked at the work the children were producing. Our adviser was very complimentary about the structure and sequence of our writing curriculum, the good use of formative assessment being used by staff during lessons (this was our Ofsted target) and the high quality of written outcomes presented in the children's work. The children spoken to also showed a clear pride in their progress and their written work. Just as they so often show a love of reading - they also demonstrated their love and enjoyment of writing.

#### **Sports**

There has been lots of sporting opportunities occurring this week. On Tuesday a group of Year 4 children went to Wodson Park to experience Tri-Golf, which is an energetic and fun version of golf in which the children complete a variety of activities, many of which include attempting to hit targets.



On Thursday Year 5 also went to Wodson Park - this time to take part in the WWW Games. During their afternoon they had the opportunity to take part in a variety of activities; rounders, dance, cricket and athletics. They were taught skills and had enjoyed several games.





In their swimming lesson this week, Year 6 had the excitement of developing their life-saving skills and learning to swim whilst fully clothed.















#### **EYFS – Superheroes**

Completing their 'Superheroes' topic, the Early Years children

had two sets of important visitors.

Firstly they had a visit from two police officers who work in the local area. The children were absolutely fascinated and were delighted to be able to explore all of the police equipment. The officers commented on the range of interesting questions

the children asked them! The impact of this visit could be seen later in the morning, when the children dressed up as police. They began writing up notes in the little notepads provided and handing out parking fines!



A huge thank you to the crew from Hoddesdon fire station who brought their fire engine to show the children in the EYFS classes, as part of their learning about 'real life superheroes'. The children learnt lots about all the equipment the engine carries and how fire officers help people.

#### **EYFS Garden**

Another recent addition to the Early Years outside area is a small shop. This is encouraging some wonderful imaginative play, especially around the shocking cost of fruit and vegetables!



#### **Art Day**

Today, Mr Cooper led the whole school 'Art Day' where the children created and took part in art activities with the theme of 'up-cycling cardboard'.

Using the artist Darrell Wakelham as inspiration, the classes used paper plates, cardboard boxes, toilet rolls and anything else made from cardboard to create Saxon helmets, animal masks, expressive faces, Roman centurions, mechanimals, pirate ships, chameleons and animals!
