

Achievement 2015 at St. Andrew's: excellent progress again!

Progress during Key Stage 2 (Teacher Assessment):

Pupils at St. Andrew's make strong progress throughout their time at our school and achieve well. There is an expectation that children will make 2 levels of progress during Key Stage 2 - from their statutory assessment at the end of Key Stage 1 to their statutory assessments at the end of Key Stage 2. Many children at St. Andrew's made better progress than this, particularly in Literacy.

2 levels of progress during Key Stage 2:

Key Stage 2 SATs Results 2015

Pupils at St. Andrew's achieve well at the end of their time with us. This year's results are good and a real tribute to the efforts of all involved - children, teachers and parents.

When comparing 2014 to 2015 "achieving more than 2 levels of progress during Key Stage 2", please remember that in 2014, the cohort had low starting points at the end of Key Stage 1 (achieving a 'sig-' in All Subjects and in Writing, and it was due to the significant progress outlined that they gained the good results in their SATs: In 2015 the pupils started from a higher starting point and therefore were able to achieve good SATs results without it showing as accelerated progress.

Reading: 100% Level 4+, 69% Level 5

Writing: 86% Level 4+, 35% Level 5+ (teacher assessed and moderated by the LA)

Maths: 93% Level 4+, 46% Level 5+ including 7% Level 6

Science: 87% Level 4+, 38% Level 5+ (teacher assessed - no SATs for Science)
